2002 NAPA VALLEY ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Hide the women and children because the Yeti of Cabs is down from Howell Mtn. Grab some t-bones and fire up the grill. Go heavy on the garlic and black pepper. The **Dutch Henry 2002 Napa Valley Estate Cabernet Sauvignon** is a big Cabernet with gripping tannins. This is what the gang drinks 'round the fire after their latest heist. Makes even a grilled rattlesnake taste good. The grapes for this wine were grown by the Chafen family on a hillside vineyard just south of the winery. This wine opens with notes of plum and cherry with a hint of clove in the bouquet. The wine finishes with black pepper and dried herbs. This is a good candidate for your cellar.
