You always liked this restaurant—the owner greets you warmly and whispers the best choices for the evening. “Skirt steak with porcini mushrooms, wild rice pilaf, and **Dutch Henry 2003 Reserve Estate Cab.**” The grapes for this Cabernet Sauvignon were grown by the Chafen family on a single hillside vineyard just south of the winery in St. Helena. The vineyard is cultivated to produce low yields of intensely flavored fruit and the wine is crafted to express the unique qualities of the *terroir*. The wine aged in French oak for 32 months. A sip...plum, cassis, notes of cedar and cola on the long, spicy finish. Life is good!
