2004 NAPA VALLEY ESTATE CABERNET SAUVIGNON “TERRIER STATION”

The grapes for this wine were grown by the Chafen family on a hillside vineyard just south of the winery on Howell Mtn. The Label was designed by Stanley Mouse who also did the album cover for the Grateful Deads “Terrapin Station”. This wine opens with notes of plum and cherry with a hint of clove in the bouquet. The wine finishes with black pepper and dried herbs. This is a good candidate for your cellar.
